

Categories of Membership and Voting Rights

- A. Certified Members hold current RID certification and must provide proof of current RID membership. Each Certified Member, in good standing, of NMRID shall be entitled to vote in meetings, on referenda, and in elections.
- B. Associate Members (non-certified members) possess skill or desire to become skilled in interpreting. Each Associate Member, in good standing, of NMRID shall be entitled to vote in meetings, on referenda, and in elections with the exception of issues pertaining to evaluations, certifications and standards.
- C. Supporting Members are all other persons whose dues are current, interested in Deaf people, their language and welfare, and the goals of NMRID, but who do not wish to maintain Certified or Associate Membership. Supporting Members shall have no vote in NMRID.
- D. Student members are part-time or full-time students in an Interpreter Preparatory Program. They are encouraged to participate in NMRID Committees. Student members shall have no vote in NMRID.
- E. Organizational members are organizations with an interest in supporting the purposes and activities of NMRID. Organizational members shall have no vote in NMRID.
